The Carlisle Area School District is proud to present the 1991-92 Carlisle High School Marching Band. The 220-member marching unit is comprised of 173 musicians, 36 band front members, 8 runners/American unit members, and 3 drum majors. Leading the band on the field are drum majors Elaine Watters, Laura Otten, and Ryan Lombardi.

This year's field show opens with "A Nightingale Sang In Barkley Square" and features trumpet soloist Brian Putz. The band next presents an arrangement of the jazz standard "That Old Black Magic" and features the 20-member saxophone section and a trumpet trio consisting of Mike Shafer, Aissa McAllen, and Alyssa Smith. The show concludes with an arrangement of "Chester", based on William Billings' Revolutionary Hymn and marching song of the same name. Soloists in this section include Erik Tack, Trumpet; Nate Stoner, Baritone; and Katie Wimer, Flugal Horn.
