The Carlisle Area School District is proud to present the Carlisle High School Marching Band's 2005 field show, "Pursuit and Capture". The band is under the field direction of Drum Majors Audrey Wronski and Zach Kuhn.

This year's field show features the music of John Williams and David Holsinger and will include color guard and band members being chased and held in "cages" throughout the show. The show is in four parts with Part I presenting the main title theme from "Catch Me If You Can", bringing to life the chase of the color guard section.
