A NEW ARRANGEMENT OF "SCARBOROUGH FAIR", PRESENTING JAZZ AND FUNK STYLES, FOLLOWS THE CLASSICAL OPENING. THE PERCUSSION SECTION IS ALSO FEATURED IN THIS SELECTION. THE 1989-90 FIELD SHOW CLOSES WITH THE EMOTIONAL "SOMEWHERE" FROM WEST SIDE STORY.

SOLOIST IN THE SHOW INCLUDE A TRUMPET DUET OF CHRIS RUEGER AND PAT COSGROVE IN FOLK SONG SUITE, AND CHIP BOWES, TRUMPET, IN SCARBOROUGH FAIR. FLUGAL HORN PLAYERS DAVID SMITH AND CHRIS SNYDER ARE FEATURED IN SOMEWHERE.

OTHER INSTRUCTORS INCLUDE TERRY BIELER, PERCUSSION, ALLEN ROTH AND VIC WERTZ, MUSIC, AND ROGER WOLF AND DAVE LANDIS, MARCHING. JT LONG IS THE BAND MANAGER.
